Operations at YYJ

There are many forms of activities that can happen around the airport that may result in noise. The airport is home to commercial aviation, general aviation, military, flying schools, search and rescue, seaplanes, air freight & courier services, fuel dealers, aircraft maintenance facilities and fixed base operators.

Aircraft activity at YYJ is made up of four main categories of aircraft operations:

- 1. Commercial air carriers: scheduled and charter passenger operations, as well as freighter aircraft, helicopter operations and seaplane services.
- 2. Private/Government: other civil aviation operations such as business aviation, private aircraft, specialized air charters, flight training, air ambulance, seaplanes, etc.
- 3. Military: military aircraft operations, both local and itinerant.
- 4. Local: civil aircraft operations in which the aircraft remains in the close proximity of the airport, normally landing and taking off at the same airport. Local operations are often carried out during training flights (touch-and-go), seaplanes, equipment tests etc.
